The Story

Connecting the Dots

Issac was one of the three Patriarchs of Israel—Abraham, Issac, and Jacob. He was in the covenant line of God's covenant with Abraham, his father. Issac had two sons, Esau and Jacob. God chose Jacob, the younger son, to carry the covenant forward. His sons are important to understanding Israel and the surrounding nations. There are not as many dramatic stories about Issac as there are of Abraham and Jacob. His is the story of faithful continuity of the promise—Jacob, King David, and ultimately Jesus.
