The Story

Connecting the Dots

The Israelites were in slavery in Egypt for 400 years. God called Moses from the burning bush to lead the people out of Egypt. After nine plagues, Pharaoh's heart was hardened. On the tenth plague the death angel passed through the land to kill the first born, but God provided salvation for Israel through the sacrifice of the Passover lamb while pointed to Jesus, who the Lamb of God who takes away the sins of the world. Moses led the Israelites out of Egypt, through the Red Sea, to Mt Sinai where he received the Law and built the Tabernacle. Moses is a type who points to Jesus as the greater prophet, the true deliverer, the perfect sacrifice, and the source of eternal life.
