Connecting the Dots

After Stephen was martyred, the church scattered. Philip led the Ethiopian Eunuch to the Lord, and the gospel went into Africa. Peter was divinely called to take the gospel to a Gentile, Cornelius. But the great expansion of the church happened in Paul's three church planting missionary trips. He went to the Province of Galatia, westward into Europe in the Province of Macedonia, and to the Province of Asia. He would revisit the churches, appoint elders, and encourage them in the faith. He took men like Timothy and Titus and mentored them to continue to strengthen the churches and plant new churches.
