The Story

There was no king in Israel.

God used the judges to lead the people out of judgement.

The people did what was right in their own eyes.

The cycle of the book of Judges is rebel, repent, rescue, repeat.

With each cycle Israel went deeper into sin.

Connecting the Dots

Judges covers the time after the death of Joshua. It records the spiritual and moral low point of the people of God. The people of Israel repeatedly broke the covenant. The Lord repeatedly showed mercy. The downward spiral of Judges is: 1. Sin—Israel departs from the Lord. 2. Oppression—God allows enemies to rule over them. 3. Cry—Israel cries out to the Lord. 4. Deliverance—God raises up a Judge. 5. Temporary Rest. 6. Relapse into sin. In each cycle of sin, Israel sunk deeper in spiritual and moral decline and the Judges became more flawed, ending with Samson. Judges points to the kings of Israel and ultimately to the Perfect King Jesus.
