

**INTRODUCTION:** Occasionally there's a "Unique One" in the Bible about which nothing negative is ever said. Maybe none quite like Caleb.

A man with "a different spirit," who served God "wholeheartedly." (Which means "to fill one's heart AND walk behind"; heart passion for God AND full obedience to God.)

What is our response? Admiration...envy...dismissal...not capable...out of our league!

**Does the Bible give us examples like Caleb just to frustrate us?  
 Where does that "different spirit" come from?  
 What makes someone "wholehearted"?**

- #1 A wholehearted person is obedient to God. (14:7)
- #2 A wholehearted person is confident in God. (v. 8)
- #3 A wholehearted person is promised an inheritance by God. (v. 9)
- #4 A wholehearted person is patient with God. (v. 10)
- #5 A wholehearted person is energetic for God. (v. 11)
- #6 A wholehearted person is dependent on God. (v. 12)

Next to the Lord Jesus himself, Caleb may just be the best person in all of Scripture to give us
