

# MESSAGE NOTES

“discip **HAVE A DIFFERENT DEFINITION OF A LIFE OF RICHES”**  
**Luke 12:13-34**

**INTRODUCTION:** It's all about the money! Follow the money that makes the world go.

### *How do we keep from being consumed by greed and worry?*

Here's a perfect illustration: "A Man in the Crowd."

*"Teacher, tell my brother to divide the inheritance with me."*

### **1. The Fool trusts earthly riches for earthly pleasure.**

- a. The Fool puts his treasures in barns for himself.
  - (1) Is what he did all that foolish?
  - (2) What he did was foolish because of his focus on himself.
- b. The Fool settles in to indulge himself.

### **2. The Fool has forgotten God and loses everything.**

- a. The Fool has forgotten that earthly things are temporary.
- b. The Fool has no relationship with God for eternity.
  - (1) Psalm 14:1 says, "The fool says in his heart, 'There is no God.'"
  - (2) When the game is over you put all the pieces back in the box,

### **3. The Disciple trusts God for earthly needs.**

- a. The Disciple does not worry about temporary earthly things.
- b. The Disciple knows that God will care for him.
  - (1) Jesus gives the illustration of the dirty birds.
  - (2) Jesus gives a critical pieces of life wisdom.

### **4. The Disciple seeks God's kingdom and gains everything.**

- a. The Disciple puts his treasures in permanent heavenly things.
  - (1) The disciple sets his/her heart on the kingdom.
  - (2) The disciple puts his/her heart where his/her treasure is.

*"If you put your \_\_\_\_\_ into \_\_\_\_\_, your heart follows that. You are interested. You want to know how it's working out."*
- b. The Disciple has a relationship with God who provides for eternity.

**CONCLUSION: Disciples keep from being consumed by greed and worry by trusting God for earthly needs and seeking God's kingdom for heavenly treasures.**
