Big Idea: Man's sin brought groaning; God's redemption reveals His glory.

- OUR GROANING (v18, 23a)
  - Suffering can either be a \_\_\_\_\_ to self-pity or an \_\_\_\_\_ to God's glory. v18a, 23a; 2 Cor 4:17
  - We often only see the \_\_\_\_\_ but God sees \_\_\_\_\_ it to something \_\_\_\_\_. v18b, Ps 119:71
- CREATION'S GROANING (v19-22)
  - It's not just \_\_\_\_\_ that suffers because of sin, it's all of \_\_\_\_\_. v19-20, Gen 3:17
  - God is not just going to end the world's groaning, He'll fully reverse the \_\_\_\_\_ and \_\_\_\_\_ of sin. v22, Rev 21:1, 5
- GOD'S GLORY (v23-25)
  - The Holy Spirit is a taste \_\_\_\_\_ of what we'll experience fully \_\_\_\_\_ when Jesus returns. v23, Matt 5:14-15
