They see their experiences, gifts, expertise, talents, and passions best used to start an organization focused in short-term mission trips connected with long-term "on the ground" workers.

Next Wave Missions aims to inspire, train, and send the next wave of short-term missionaries to the nations. Their main target is churches with their focus next year being in Thailand, Israel, and Costa Rica.
