

MESSAGE NOTES

"Moving Forward: 'Hero Harlot'" [Joshua 2]

INTRODUCTION: Halls of Fame. For the Christian: the Hall of Faith in Hebrews 11. Abel, Enoch, Noah, Abraham, Sarah, Jacob, Moses, Rahab?! How did she get in there?

What was it that was so extraordinary about her faith? What about your faith?

REVIEW:

- The Israelites are poised on the banks of the Jordan River, ready to follow Joshua.
- Joshua received God's Word giving God's promise of his presence and victory to give him strength and courage.
- He has given the immediate marching orders and unified the people for the conquest.
- 1. Rahab's great faith is not demonstrated by what she had.
 - ...in the way of a godly heritage.
 - ...in the way of a good reputation.
 - ...in the way of a great knowledge.
- 2. Rahab's great faith was demonstrated by what she did with what she had.
 - ...in the way of application and obedience.
- 3. Our great faith is not demonstrated by what we have.
 - ...in the way of our great heritage.
 - ...in the way of our good reputation.
 - ...in the way of our great knowledge.
- 4. Our great faith is demonstrated by what we do with what we have.
- It's not called the "Intentions of the Apostles," or the "Strategic Plans of the Apostles," or the 'Dreams of the Apostles," but the "Acts of the Apostles."
- Hope for us from Hebrews 6:9-11:

Even though we speak like this, dear friends, we are convinced of better things in your case—the things" that have to do with salvation. God is not unjust; he will not forget your work and the love you have shown him as you have helped his people and continue to help them. We want each of you to show this same diligence to the very end, so that what you hope for may be fully realized."

CONCLUSION: Rahab is in the lineage of the Lord Jesus himself!

"Ram the father of Amminadab, Amminadab the father of Nahshon, Nahshon the father of Salmon, Salmon the father of Boaz, whose mother was Rahab, Boaz the father of Obed, whose mother was Ruth, Obed the father of Jesse, and Jesse the father of King David." (Matthew 1:4-6a.)
