MESSAGE NOTES

"THE CHURCH'S ID is THE WORD!" Acts 3:12-26

QUESTION: How do we know what we know?

- What is the **source** of our knowledge?
- How do we **receive** and understand the knowledge?

Psalm 19 "The heavens and the Law." (The Christian worldview)

ANSWER #1: God has revealed Himself in His Word.

John 1:1-3, 14 "The Word was. The Word became flesh"

ANSWER #2: God has revealed He is The Word.

Luke 24:24-27, 30-32, 44-45 "The reason for Holy Heartburn"

ANSWER #3: God has revealed Himself in The Word: Jesus.

Ephesians 2:19-20 "The apostles and prophets with Jesus as chief cornerstone"

ANSWER #4: God has revealed Jesus for His church in his Word.

Acts 2:42 "Devoted to the apostles' teaching"

Acts 3:12-26 "Faith is Christ-centered. Faith is Bible-grounded."

ANSWER #5: God has revealed Jesus by the Spirit for today in the Bible.

For the few so-called problems with the Bible:

- There are answers: **find them.**
- There are answers yet to find: **seek them.**
- There are some answers that will never be found: **accept that.**
- There are answers God never intended us to find: **trust him.**

ANSWER #6: God has revealed Jesus by the Spirit for FBC in the Bible.

For past, present and future unity.

- For the preacher.
- For the ministry leaders and life group leaders.
- For our personal devotions.

CONCLUSION:

QUESTION: How do we know what we know?

ANSWER: God has told us! **GOD HAS REVEALED JESUS BY THE SPIRIT FOR HIS PEOPLE IN HIS WORD.**

Devotion to the Bible means rejecting the "abbreviated" Great Commission.
