

MESSAGE NOTES

“disciples” **Have a Different View of Heaven and Hell” Luke 16:19-31**

INTRODUCTION: Living in denial. It doesn't end well!

But one of the most popular denials is denial of judgment and hell.

“How can you say that a loving God condemns people to an eternal hell?”

“How could a loving God eternally torture people in hellfire for a few mistakes they made over a few years on earth?”

“How could there even be a hell? Doesn't the amazing love of God overrule death and hell in the end?”

1. LIFE IS TOUGH.

a. Life is unfair for Lazarus and the rich man.

b. Life is unfair for all of us.

2. DEATH BRINGS JUSTICE.

a. God makes it right in the end.

b. God makes it right based on the heart.

3. JUSTICE IS FINAL.

a. The two destinations are permanent.

b. This means that all that happens in this lifetime really matters for eternity!

c. The real issue is the heart.

Sometimes the very same people who cried “life is not fair!” will yell out “death is not fair!”

“After death, won't people change their hearts?”

“Why won't God give them a second chance?”

“Why can't people turn to God and be saved after they die?”

4. FINAL JUSTICE IS FAIR.

a. In torment, the rich man has NOT changed!

b. He even tries to shift the blame for his situation back on God.

c. But God's Word in this life is sufficient.

d. God knows who has made him God of their hearts and who has not.

e. Heaven and hell will be the just and fair destination of everyone.

CONCLUSION: THIS LIFETIME IS ENOUGH TIME TO REVEAL THE GOD OF OUR HEARTS, WHICH DETERMINES OUR DESTINY BEYOND TIME.
