MOVING FORWARD: “MORE TERRITORY TO TAKE.” - JOSHUA 11-13

INTRODUCTION: “Mission Accomplished!” (Well, maybe not just yet!)

- What about when you get to the finish line and you realize you are not finished?
- After we celebrated a victory God has given, we should ask, “Lord, what’s next?”

Review of Joshua chapters 1-10.

LESSONS FOR US ABOUT GOD:

- #1. God will be with His people: The Israelites.
- a. We learn about his salvation.
 - b. We learn about his guidance.

- #2. God will judge his enemies: The Canaanites.
- a. We learn about his certain judgment.
 - b. We learn of His mercy in judgment.

- #3. God will establish his kingdom: The Promised Land.
- a. We learn of His sovereign ways.
 - b. We learn of His cosmic power.

LESSONS FOR US ABOUT US:

- #1. We must seek him first.
- a. We must inquire of God.
 - b. We must consecrate ourselves to God.

- #2. We must obey him completely.

- #3. We will experience his victory.
- a. In the battles of life.
 - (1) The Eastern Campaign: (Numbers 21)
 - (2) The Central Campaign: (ch 6-8)
 - (3) The Southern Campaign: (ch. 9-10)
 - (4) The Northern Campaign: (ch. 11-12)
 - b. In the inheritance / rest of life.

BUT... THEY WERE NOT FINISHED: (ch.13-19)

- #1 There were pockets of enemy resistance.
- #2 There was a new and different strategy for a new day.

AND...NEITHER ARE WE:

- #1 God has blessed mightily in years past!
- #2 There is more territory to take!
- #3 These new challenges will require some new strategies.

CONCLUSION: GOD’S PEOPLE NEED TO REALIZE THERE IS MORE TERRITORY TO TAKE, WITH THE SAME GOAL...BUT NEW STRATEGIES.
