Primary Ministry Focus:

Kent and Kimberly Rasmussen have been serving faithfully as part of Wycliffe Bible Translator for 25 years. Their work involves translating both the Old and New Testament into various indigenous languages that have previously not had access to the Scriptures. Kent has packed his bags once again to go serve in Cameroon. He has a new phone app they've been using already that will streamline onboarding his AZT program. There are at least 3 goals: Develop two new alphabets; train a local team on these tools - discipling them to work in a Christ-like way; and record 3-minute stories. Kim spent this year learning her new role as an Assistant Font Designer. She finds great irony in joining a Technology Department. This summer, she's had the opportunity to study Type Design online from a professional in New York. Her first font is in development!

- Kent is traveling in Cameroon for 2 weeks, working on alphabets for his #66 and #67 languages. Both teams will travel from conflict zones to meet him in the capital. Pray for health for the whole team (no malaria this time), safety, baggage, technology and power to get this work done.
- Pray for the Cameroonian linguists Kent will be training to use his software. These experts may finish the last alphabets needed in their country.
