

Missionary Update

Bridge Builders International (BBI), was founded by our own Chuck Kelley and his wife Nancy, officially in 1995 after following in the footsteps of Chuck's Latvian grandfather, Charles Singer, and his ministry IRM (International Refugee Mission; they officially merged in 1996). Natalie Meeks is President & CEO, Joshua Masters is Executive Director, and Chuck is still involved as President Emeritus.

BBI has 4 paths of ministry:

Imago Dei - ministry to artists

Eagle's Wings Camp - youth discipleship program

Ukrainian War Relief - ministry to Ukrainian war victims and refugees inside Latvia and within the borders of Ukraine.

Balt Care Net - equips, disciples, and nurtures pastors and caregivers in the Baltic countries.

Please be praying for the following:

- **Christmas Outreach** - Following the Christmas and New Year calendars of Latvia and the Russian Orthodox Church, BBI will meet the pastoral and physical needs of Ukrainian Refugees by delivering Christmas food boxes and presents in 10 refugee communities throughout Latvia. Also, the Gospel will be shared and this will continue the relationships BBI has already built with these communities as they share the hope of Christ that Christmas represents. *[Russian Orthodox Christians actively celebrate Christmas on January 7th. The date differs from Western traditions because they follow the Julian calendar.]*

- **Humanitarian aid effort** (ongoing) - In cooperation with BBI's Latvian Partneri team and Baltic Global Initiative, BBI representatives have and will travel to both Ukraine and Latvia, ministering to refugees in Latvia and delivering much needed supplies (food, medical supplies, and beds for those displaced by the war) into Ukraine.

- **Bible studies in Latvia and the US** - people's hunger for and growth with God.

- **Guidance and direction** for the leadership of this ministry and their Latvian partners, the Latvian Partneri Team.
