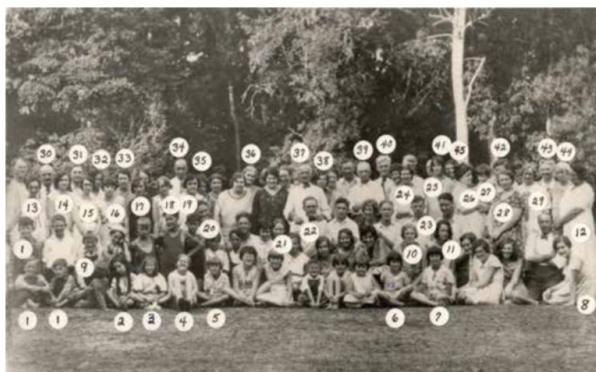


PICNIC LUNCH

Acts 4:23-35

Worship on the mission field

The Early church **GATHERED** after preaching success amidst opposition to: **REPORT & PROCESS** (v23-28)– reporting results and processing obstacles Scripturally

PRAY & PLEAD (v25-30) – praying Biblically reflective prayers and plead for signs and boldness

RECEIVE & RETURN (v31-35)– receiving miracles and Holy Spirit boldness before returning to the task of testifying about Jesus

BREAKOUT DIRECTIONS....Report and Process

1. In our study of Acts 1-3, We the Church Must Be the Church, what stands out to you the most?
2. How have you integrated what you heard from God into your life? How have you obeyed?
3. Have you shared your faith lately? With who? How did it go?
HAVE SOMEONE READ today's passage again – Acts 4:23-35
4. What stands out to you from this passage?
5. What does it teach us about the Lord, the Son, the Spirit? And us as people?

Receiving Boldness and Miraculous Answers to Prayer

RAPID FIRE Prayer ... Praying reflective prayers and Pleading for Boldness

Let's close our service with a stream of you praying short prayers in succession that:

- a. Reflect Biblical truth
- b. Plead for miracles and boldness to share the Gospel story

Keep prayers to 20 seconds or less - BE BOLD come up front to a mic.
