**INTRODUCTION:** “Have you ever had an **AWESTRUCK** moment with God?”  
 If you do, how will you respond?”

## ◆ CHRIST'S GLORY ON THE MOUNTAIN

1. Jesus is praying.
2. Jesus is trans**FIGURED**. He is not trans**FORMED** into something else.
3. Jesus is joined by Moses and Elijah.
4. (Then all of a sudden...) Peter is talking!
5. So, God speaks.

**SILENCED BY CHRIST'S GLORY SO THEY WILL LISTEN TO CHRIST ALONE.**

## ◆ THE WORLD'S WICKEDNESS IN THE VALLEY

1. The challenge of the demon-possessed boy. (37-43a)  
 - Listen to Christ alone for the kind of FAITH for the toughest challenges.
2. The knowledge of the prominence of Jesus' death. (43b-45)  
 - Listen to Christ alone for UNDERSTANDING of salvation which comes later.
3. The argument for personal greatness. (46-48)  
 - Listen to Christ alone for HUMILITY before Christ and others.
4. The envy of other followers of Jesus. (49-50)  
 - Listen to Christ alone for ACCEPTANCE of others.
5. The angry judgment of the lost. (51-55)  
 - Listen to Christ alone for MERCY toward others.
- 6-8. The priority of the world over Jesus. (56-62)  
 - Listen to Christ alone to learn SACRIFICE in following the Lord.

- We too must be...

## ◆ SILENCED BY CHRIST'S GLORY SO WE CAN LISTEN TO CHRIST ALONE.

- For FAITH in the toughest challenges of others.
- For UNDERSTANDING of salvation.
- For HUMILITY before Christ and others.
- For ACCEPTANCE of others who also believe.
- For MERCY toward others.
- To learn SACRIFICE in following the Lord.
