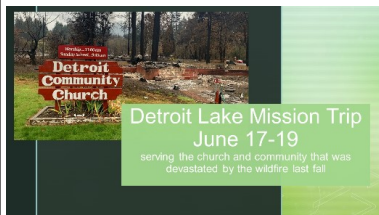

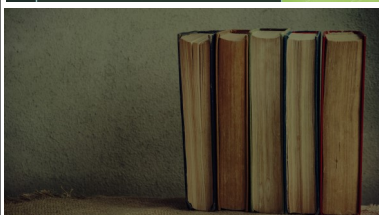
This is an all church meeting on Zoom on Sunday 6/6. The agenda for this meeting is available as a separate insert. The Zoom Link and info is also available on the church website.

MESSAGE NOTES

"THE CHURCH'S IDENTITY IS AWE!" Acts 3:1-16

INTRODUCTION: Standing in awe of what is "Awesome!"???

- Our casual expression.
- Our personal experiences.
- The regular response to Jesus.
- Our regular response to Jesus?

How do we stand in awe of Jesus now? How do we stay standing in awe?

This posture of heart, soul, mind and body awe is part of the Identity or DNA of the church given by the Holy Spirit from the Day of Pentecost to today (Acts 2:43).

1. JESUS MAKES THE LAME MAN WALK. (3:1-8)

- Jesus continues to do miracles...
 - ...at the crowded Temple.
 - ...through Peter and John.
 - ...with the man's dramatic, exuberant response.

2. THE PEOPLE ARE (STILL) AMAZED AND ASTONISHED. (3:9-11)

- Jesus continues to amaze...
 - ...overwhelming the people.
 - ...once again, (and again, and again...).

3. PETER DIRECTS THE FOCUS AND PRAISE TO JESUS. (3:12-16)

- Jesus is the awesome one...
 - ...not Peter and John.
 - ...just look at who He is (and what you did to Him).
 - ...just look at what God did for Jesus and what Jesus did for this man.

CONCLUSION: WE CAN CONTINUE TO BE IN AWE OF JESUS WHEN THE WORK OF JESUS CONTINUES IN THE NAME OF JESUS.

Like Peter and John, we must keep the focus on Jesus as we move forward.
We are witnesses of Him. It is all about Him.

- We must continually look at His person and work.
- We must continually direct the focus and praise to Him.
- We must continually acknowledge Him as The Awesome One!
