MESSAGE NOTES

„əpɪdɪsɪp „ **Make Completely Different Confessions of Faith” Luke 9:1-27**

INTRODUCTION: What does it mean to be a Beaver Basketball player?
You are what you are when you do what you do.

So, what does it mean to be a disciple of Jesus? A “əpɪdɪsɪp” “səpɪdɪsɪp.”

1. A “əpɪdɪsɪp” follows Jesus. (beginning with repentance and belief)
2. A “əpɪdɪsɪp” knows Jesus. (Who he is!)
3. A “əpɪdɪsɪp” responds to Jesus. (respond, receive more, respond, receive more...)
4. A “əpɪdɪsɪp” disciples by delivering Jesus’ message and mission to others.

Jesus is going to deliver his message & mission through his disciples. (1-27)

This is the first missionary assignment for disciples to deliver the message. (1-11)

- Dependence: on God.
- Rejection: the possibility, even probability.
- Discernment: when to move on with peace or judgment.

This is the first miracle assignment for disciples to deliver the mission. (12-17)

- Christ’s compassion.
- Christ’s Creator identity.
- Christ’s call to obey.
- Christ’s compassionate and abundant provision.
- Christ’s concern for them.

This is the first Messiah declaration by the disciples. (18-20)

Jesus is going to accomplish his message & mission through his death and resurrection. (21-22)

5. A “əpɪdɪsɪp” dies. (23-25)
 - Deny self.
 - Take up their cross daily.
 - Follow Christ and lose their life.
6. A “əpɪdɪsɪp” rises to glory. (26-27)

CONCLUSION:

“səpɪdɪsɪp” FOLLOW JESUS THROUGH DEATH AND RESURRECTION TO DELIVER HIS MESSAGE & MISSION.

The carrying of the cross and the coming of the glory.
 That’s what it means to be Jesus’ “əpɪdɪsɪp”!
