INTRODUCTION: The picture of Jesus problem.

- Isaiah 53:2b-3a "He had no beauty or majesty to attract us to him, nothing in his appearance that
 we should desire him. He was despised and rejected by mankind, a man of suffering, and familiar
 with pain."
- Hebrews 1:9 "You have loved righteousness and hated wickedness; therefore God, your God, has set you above your companions by anointing you with the oil of joy."
- Luke 10:21 "At that time Jesus, full of joy through the Holy Spirit..."
 What happened, what was going on that made Jesus smile that day?
- 1. JESUS CHOSE AND SENT OUT THE SEVENTY WITH THE GOSPEL. (1-16)
 - a. He is the Lord of the Harvest.
 - b. He sends them out to bring the Kingdom of God gospel. Go...
 - ...in vulnerability
 - ...in dependency
 - ...with urgency
 - ...to bring peace
 - ...with contentment
 - ...with a clear kingdom message
 - ...to bring judgment
 - ...as Christ's ambassadors
- 2. THE SEVENTY CAME BACK WITH JOY. (17-20)
 - a. This mission is a high point of a success.
 - b. This mission is a cosmic battle to defeat evil.
 - c. This mission points to the reason for true joy: eternal life.
- 3. JESUS RESPONDED WITH JOY, PRAISE AND BLESSING, (21-24)
 - a. Jesus is joyful because of God's plan to reach all people.
 - b. Jesus was joyful because of this the chain of revelation.
 - c. Jesus was joyful because of his unique mutual bond with Father.
 - d. Jesus is joyful because of the blessing his disciples are now receiving.

CONCLUSION: " ⁵ ³ | ^d ¹ ² ⁵ ! P " who labor in the Lord's harvest will bring peace and judgment and joy to others...AND this brings joy to Jesus...AND that will bring us joy!
