He has decades of experience working with college students on campus. He is finishing up his tenure as the Graduate Fellowship Ministry New England Area Director.

- ◆ Please pray for: *Grad students are notoriously weak on reaching out to share their faith but a group of Brown U students are using a curriculum called BLESS which focuses on reaching out. One student named John has been having a movie nights on the theme of redemption and inviting his friends. They order pizza, have dinner and watch a movie, discussing it afterwards. Not only are people coming but John is growing in his faith. Pray that the Lord will use this in a wonderful way for John and in the Christian grad group and in the lives of the friends. *Len recently hosted a gathering of Christian faculty in the NE area, exploring different possibilities of connecting with others on their campuses. Ask the Lord to use this time as one more step in birthing more Christian faculty groups in New England.

Chuck Kelley (Bridge Builders International)

On a 6 week ministry trip to Latvia and Poland. During the time he is there he will lead a three day prayer summit with 80 leaders of mercy ministries in the Baltic's and Ukraine. Eagle Winds Camp will be hosting a construction team that will be supporting those going into Poland on the Ukrainian border. Large shipments of food will be sent over the border.

- ◆ While in Poland Chuck will be taking part in the European Leadership Forum, a gathering of 600 Christians. He will be speaking to the contingency of 30-35 artists from over 20 countries. The focus is to challenge believers to use their gifting to reach their world for Christ. Pray that God will strengthen Chuck for the physical challenges of this trip and safety as he travels. Pray that those who attend Prayer Days to be encouraged in their work with those who are hurting. Ask God to give him wisdom as he collaborates with the effort being made in Latvia on behalf of Ukrainian refugees. Remember Nancy and his family while he is away. He returns May 28

We aim to encounter God through worship, to connect with others through smaller communities, and to engage in missional outreach to our neighbors and the nations.




