MESSAGE NOTES

MOVING FORWARD: “THE LORD COMES TO TAKE OVER” - JOSHUA 5

INTRODUCTION: JOSHUA: “Okay, now what?”

How do we take ground for God with God on our side?”

- We face walled-up challenges or impending battles and we stop to think through our options and strategy. We pray to go through and get through with God.
- Our role as a church is to make mature disciples, connecting the next generation to Jesus. He is the only hope for a world who desperately needs his love and salvation.
- Here’s God’s plan for Joshua and the Israelites: Joshua 5:2.
 JOSHUA: “You’ve got to be kidding! That’s crazy.”

1. You take ground for God marked by His ownership. (2-9)
 - a. God’s mark on Israel was circumcision.
 - b. God’s mark on us is baptism. (Colossians 2:11-13)
2. You take ground for God remembering his salvation. (10-12)
 - a. God’s salvation of Israel was remembered by the exodus/Passover meal.
 - b. God’s salvation for us is remembered by the Lord’s Supper meal.
3. You take ground for God surrendered to his command. (13-15)
 - a. God’s asserts his command of Israel.

“God doesn’t come to take sides, he comes to take over, and to take us with him!”

- b. God asserts his command of us.

CONCLUSION: Your relationship with him is more important than your work for him.
YOU WILL TAKE GROUND FOR GOD WHEN GOD TAKES COMMAND OF YOU.

- Confessing His ownership. Galatians 5:22-25
“But the fruit of the Spirit is love, joy, peace, forbearance, kindness, goodness, faithfulness, gentleness and self-control. Against such things there is no law. Those who belong to Christ Jesus have crucified the flesh with its passions and desires. Since we live by the Spirit, let us keep in step with the Spirit.”
- Remembering his salvation. 2 Timothy 1:9-10
“He has saved us and called us to a holy life—not because of anything we have done but because of his own purpose and grace. This grace was given us in Christ Jesus before the beginning of time, but it has now been revealed through the appearing of our Savior, Christ Jesus, who has destroyed death and has brought life and immortality to light through the gospel.”
- Celebrating the ordinances of baptism and the Lord’s Supper.
