

## PURPOSE DRIVEN LIVES Phil 1:27-2:4

Big Idea: Having a clear sense of God's purpose not only changes us personally, but it changes how we react and interact with the world around us.

- GOD'S PURPOSE CHANGES US PERSONALLY (v27-28)
  - Gospel-driven lives mean that we live like we're \_\_\_\_\_ of heaven and only \_\_\_\_\_ on Earth. Jn 15:19
  - When we allow our heavenly citizenship to shape us, it also impacts how we \_\_\_\_\_ the world around us. Acts 4:13
- GOD'S PURPOSE CHANGES HOW WE REACT TO DIFFICULTIES (v29-30)
  - Living with God's purpose enables us to see that suffering and hardships are indications that God is \_\_\_\_\_, not \_\_\_\_\_. 1 Pet 5:10
  - Suffering is a gift to us because it's an indication that we're \_\_\_\_\_ in the messy, challenging, difficult battle of being salt and light to others. Eph 6:10-12
- GOD'S PURPOSE CHANGES HOW WE INTERACT AS A COMMUNITY (v1-4)
  - Unity isn't doing the same things, it's not doing things the same, it's doing things for the same \_\_\_\_\_. Rom 15:6
  - We build unity by developing a " \_\_\_\_\_ " attitude rather than a " \_\_\_\_\_ " attitude. Prov 11:2, 16:18, 29:23; James 4:6; Mk 12:30-31
