Praises and updates:

- Our church planters retreat was held in Cuenca, where we enjoyed prayer, bible teaching, sharing ministry and family burdens and successes, fellowship, and fun activities. We also welcomed three new church-planting couples serving in Amaluza-Carimanga, Vinces, and Catacocha.
- Our Vacation Bible School, Semilla de Mostaza, had an excellent outreach with 130 children and 35 volunteers. Several mothers stayed during VBS, giving Lulu an opportunity to begin a monthly women's Bible study and craft time, continuing a ministry that began 23 years ago.
- Our women had a wonderful retreat, beginning with a kickoff event attended by 110 women. Sixty-five women from Loja and surrounding areas traveled many miles to participate in the retreat.
- Our youth camp was a great success, with 28 high school students attending. The speakers taught practical ways to share the gospel.
