'The focus is to challenge believers to use their gifting to reach their world for Christ. Pray that God will strengthen Chuck for the physical challenges of this trip and safety as he travels. # MESSAGE NOTES

“*sc̄ip̄sc̄ip̄* Walk A Different Road From Now to Eternity” [Luke 24:1-36]

**INTRODUCTION:** “Life is a journey, not a destination.” We know this. (*Not that we always or ever live this way! This means everything is constantly changing. We don't like that!*)

The one thing in all time and eternity that has altered both the journey and the destination for everyone more than anything else: \_\_\_\_\_! **Are you on the journey!**

## 1. We go from Jesus' death to Jesus' life.

v. 5-6 “Why do you look for the living among the dead? He is not here; he has risen!”

> **We join the journey!**

## 2. We go from wondering to knowing.

v. 6-8 “Remember how he told you, while he was still with you in Galilee: ‘The Son of Man must be delivered over to the hands of sinners, be crucified and on the third day be raised again.’ Then they remembered his words.”

> **We join the journey!**

## 3. We go from a separated Bible to an all-together Bible.

v. 25-27 “How foolish you are and how slow to believe all that the prophets have spoken! Did not the Messiah have to suffer these things and then enter his glory?” And beginning with Moses and all the Prophets, he explained to them what was said in all the Scriptures concerning himself.”

- Maybe: Genesis 3 (heir of Eve); Genesis 22 (sacrifice of son); Exodus 12 (Passover); Leviticus 16 (Day of Atonement); Numbers 21 (wilderness serpent); Psalm. 22 (crucifixion death); Isaiah 53 (suffering servant); Zachariah 11, 12, 13 (detailed Messiah prophecies of coming and death).

> **We join the journey!**

## 4. We go from doubt to faith.

## 5. We go from the empty tomb to full hearts.

> **We join the journey!**

## 6. We go from Jesus as a man to Jesus The Lord.

“Lord, Jesus, Son of Man, Jesus of Nazareth, prophet, Jesus, Messiah, and Lord”

> **We join the journey!**

## 7. We go from this world to the next world.

- God's answer in Jesus for afterlife and after-death: “Resurrection and eternal life in perfected, redeemed, glorious, God given, God glorifying eternal bodies!”

> **We join the journey!** “Death is a journey, not a destination.”

**CONCLUSION: THE RESURRECTION SETS US ON A COMPLETELY NEW JOURNEY WITH GOD, AS JESUS TAKES US FROM DEATH TO LIFE.**
