Missionary Update

Bridge Builders International (BBI), was founded by our own Chuck Kelley and his wife Nancy, officially in 1994 after following in the footsteps of Chuck's Latvian grandfather, Charles Singer, and his ministry the International Refugee Mission. They formally merged in 1996. Today, Natalie Meeks is President & CEO, Joshua Masters is Executive Director, and Chuck is still involved as President Emeritus. BBI has four paths of ministry. These areas not only allow BBI to meet the individual needs of those they serve but also encourage churches and individuals to get involved in the ministry where they feel most passionate about God's calling:

Imago Dei - ministry to artists in several countries

Eagle's Wings Camp - youth evangelism and discipleship program

Ukrainian War Relief - ministry to Ukrainian war victims and refugees inside Latvia and within the borders of Ukraine.

BaltCareNet - equips, disciples, and nurtures pastors and caregivers in the Baltic countries. **Please be praying for the following:**

- **Christmas Outreach** BBI meets the spiritual and physical needs of Ukrainian Refugees by delivering Christmas food boxes and presents to ten refugee communities throughout Latvia. The Gospel is shared in this process, and people are invited to give their lives to the Lord.
- **Humanitarian aid effort** (ongoing) In cooperation with BBI's Latvian Partneri team and Baltic Global Initiative, BBI team members travel to both Ukraine and Latvia, ministering to war victims and delivering much-needed supplies (food, medical supplies, and beds, and more.
- **Guidance and direction** for the leaders of this ministry, Natalie, Josh, and Chuck in the US, as well as Almers, Vineta, Efi, Diks, and Gatis in Latvia.



His books include: Science and Religion: A Historical Introduction, Medicine & Religion: A Historical Introduction, Medicine & Health Care in Early Christianity.

Dr. Ferngren's research interests also include the history of early Christianity, ancient medical texts, and the ways in which scientific ideas have been received and integrated into religious traditions. He has served as a mentor to countless students, inspiring a new generation of scholars in both the humanities and the sciences, and encouraging them in their Christian faith.
