MESSAGE NOTES

MOVING FORWARD: "SECRET SINS ARE NEVER SECRET" - JOSHUA 7-8

INTRODUCTION: What is the harm of secret sin? After all...

"You can do whatever you want in the privacy of your own life and home, as long as you don't hurt anyone."

...Right? (Or is that wrong? Terribly wrong!)

REVIEW:

- The walls of Jericho have fallen. A wicked people faced the judgment of God.
- The prostitute Rahab has been saved. An obedient woman shown the mercy of God.
- The Israelites devoted the battle to the Lord. A people given victory by God.

1. There is a secret sin.

2. Secret sin brings complete defeat.

- a. Achan's sin brought the complete defeat of all Israel.
 - (1) Achan's sin brings literal military defeat...
 ... **defeat** to Israel's army at Ai.
 ... **derailment** of the conquest of the land.
 - (2) Achan's sin brings the defeat of morale...
 ... **despair** of the people.
 ... **discouragement** to their leader Joshua.
 - (3) Achan's sin brings spiritual defeat...
 ... **defiant** rebellion of God's clear commands.
 ... **disgrace** to the Lord's name.
 ... **discipline** by God.
 - (4) Achan's sin brings his death...
 ... **discovery** of sin and sinner.
 ... **declaration** of sin.
 ... **deserved death**.
- b. Our sin brings complete defeat. (He saw, coveted, took, hid.) (James 1:14-15)
 - (1) Our sin brings literal physical defeat. (even death)
 - (2) Our sin brings others' defeat.
 - (3) Our sin brings spiritual defeat.

3. God gives the remedy for secret sin.

- a. Achan's sin was exposed, confessed and cleansed.
- b. Our sin is exposed, and cleansed. (Numbers 32:23, Luke 12:2, 1 John 1:9, James 5:16, Romans 10:9, 2 Corinthians 5:21, 1 Peter 2:24)

Achan got exactly what he deserved. Christ got exactly what we deserved.

4. Secret sin exposed, confessed and cleansed opens the way for victory.

- a. With Achan's sin gone, Israel could move on to victory.
- b. With our sin gone, we can move on to victory.

**CONCLUSION: SECRET SIN EXPOSED, CONFESSED & CLEANSED
 OPENS THE WAY FOR VICTORY.**
