Big Idea: It's easy to become a huddled church but there's hope—it doesn't have to stay that way.

- **BECOMING HUDDLED (v14-17)**

- Lukewarm isn't about their spiritual \_\_\_\_\_ but their \_\_\_\_\_ for the spiritual condition of \_\_\_\_\_. v14-16, Col 1-4, Matt 5:13
