We aim to encounter God through worship, to connect with others through smaller communities, and to engage in missional outreach to our neighbors and the nations.



Transitory Housing for Refugees

We're offering the house on 35th Street to be used for incoming refugee families to live in for 3-6 months while they find permanent housing. The first family will be ready to move in on March 30th so we need to get the place ready. Here's what we need:

- **Furniture/Household Items to be donated.** A list of what is needed was emailed out and is available in the lobby. Leslie Anderson (leslie@darylanderson.com) is the point of contact to donate or for questions.
- **Cleaning Team.** The house has been vacant and closed up for some time so it needs a good cleaning before it's ready to be lived in. We need a team of 4-5 people to get it clean and ready. Diana Parmenter (jdiana@peak.org) is leading this effort. If you are interested in helping do this, please contact Diana.
- **Church Work Day to Set Up.** Mark your calendar for March 18 for a church work day. We'll need to gather all the donated items, move them to the house, and set everything up. More details will follow on this, but for now block out some (or most) of that day to help get everything ready.
