THE MUSIC IN OUR WORSHIP

The opening voluntary begins with “There Is a Balm in Gilead,” a spiritual long associated with comfort and healing, and a favorite of the Rev. Dr. Martin Luther King, Jr. for its message of restoration. “Lift Every Voice and Sing” continues these themes of hope and confidence in God’s power.

We welcome Caroline Hethcox this morning at the 8:45am service. Caroline will sing “Assurance,” arranged by John Ness Beck, for the offertory. The song is based on the familiar hymn, “Blessed Assurance,” by Fanny Crosby. Caroline is a senior at River Bluff High School in Lexington and a member of Shandon.

Our Chancel Choir will sing two anthems at the 11am service arranged by American composer, Moses Hogan (1957-2003). “Hear My Prayer,” and “My Soul’s Been Anchored in the Lord,” are two of his most popular anthems based on spirituals. “My Soul’s Been Anchored in the Lord,” was composed for Sonja Sepulveda and the Sumter High School Concert Choir, Sumter, SC, in 1998.

The closing voluntary is a four-hands piano duet performed by Kipp Gill and Kipp’s friend Mary Christian. Mary Christian is an English professor at Middle Georgia State University who also enjoys playing piano and composing.
