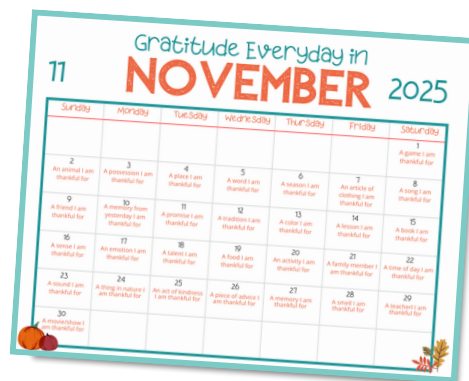
YOUNG PROFESSIONALS LUNCH

CHRISTMAS BAGS FOR CHILDREN OF HAITI

Each year, the Methodist Church of Haiti distributes Christmas stockings to children in need—many of whom would not otherwise receive a gift. You can help by preparing a stocking filled with the following items:

- 4.6 oz or larger, tube of toothpaste
- One medium-sized toothbrush
- One full-size bar of antibacterial soap (ex., Dial)
- One washcloth
- One large tooth comb
- One toy (something small), e.g., stuffed animal
- A bag of mints or hard candy (individually wrapped candies)
- All of the above should be packaged in a one or two-gallon-sized Ziploc bag. We encourage you to use Christmas stickers to decorate the Ziploc bag.

Please send \$2.00 for each Christmas stocking to help cover the shipping expenses. These kits will be collected at the United Methodist Volunteers in Missions warehouse in Batesburg-Leesville, SC, and from there, shipped to Haiti.

To cover shipping expenses, please make all checks out to UMVIM-SC/Christmas Stockings. Checks can accompany the stockings or be mailed to: Jennifer Parker, Treasurer UMVIM-SC, 143 Glenbrooke Circle, Columbia, SC 29204.

All stockings must be delivered to the UMVIM warehouse by November 5, to ensure they can be delivered to Haiti by Christmas. The warehouse address is 117 West Church Street, Batesburg, SC 29006.

SAFE SANCTUARY REMINDER OF THE MONTH - TWO ADULT RULE

1. One adult shall not be in a room, area, or vehicle with a single child or youth at any time, on or off campus.
2. Two or more policy-certified adults shall be present during any church-sponsored program, event, or ministry involving children. When two of these adults are related, another unrelated Safe Sanctuary-certified adult shall be present.
3. In circumstances when only one policy-certified adult is present in a room with a group of youth, the doors to the room will be left open, and the room will be visible from the hallway or another room. Persons in adjoining or nearby rooms shall be made aware that only one adult is present with the youth in that other room.
4. At drop-off, a parent shall wait with the child until two unrelated, policy-certified leaders/teachers are present.
5. In the absence of two unrelated and policy-approved leaders/teachers, groups shall be combined, or leaders redistributed.
