Shandon's Child & Youth Abuse Prevention Procedures Reminder of the Month: "Two-Adults Rule" (Part A) One adult shall not be in a room, area, or vehicle with a single child or youth at any time, on or off campus. Two or more policy-certified adults shall be present during any church-sponsored program, event, or ministry involving children (infants - 5th graders). When two of these adults are related, another unrelated Safe Sanctuary-certified adult shall be present.

At drop-off, a parent shall wait with the child until two unrelated, policy-certified leaders/teachers are present.
