Hurricane Helene has severely impacted many, with people losing power, homes, businesses, and even loved ones. Others are still searching for missing family members. Now, many of us are looking for ways to help our brothers, sisters, and neighbors recover and rebuild. By working together, we can meet the needs of our community and beyond. Here are three ways you can make a difference: volunteer, provide, and pray.

Volunteer your time: Epworth Foster families need our help. One local family requires assistance with meals, and another needs formula and groceries. If you'd like to help, email Rev.
