DAY 3 – The Daily Choice of Surrender

SCRIPTURE TO READ:

Romans 12:1 (NKJV)

"I beseech you therefore, brethren, by the mercies of God, that you present your bodies a living sacrifice, holy, acceptable to God, which is your reasonable service." (Optional Additional Reading: Luke 9:23)

THINK IT THROUGH:

Paul uses the word "present"—an intentional act, not a one-time event. The trouble with a living sacrifice is that it wants to crawl off the altar. That's why surrender isn't something we check off once and move on from. Jesus said, "Take up your cross daily and follow Me." Each day we choose again to place ourselves in God's hands, offering Him our plans, our priorities, and our desires.

PUT IT INTO PRACTICE:

Before you head into your responsibilities today, pause to pray a simple prayer: "Lord, I choose again today to surrender." Start your morning this way, and repeat it whenever you feel the pull to take control back.

PRAYER FOR TODAY:

"Lord, help me to choose surrender today and every day. Keep me on the altar, willing and available for Your purpose."

GO FURTHER

Set a reminder on your phone for later today with the words: "Choose surrender again." Let it bring you back to this truth in the middle of your day.
