

DAY 5 – *Clarity Comes Through Surrender*

SCRIPTURE TO READ:

Romans 12:2 (NKJV)

“...that you may prove what is that good and acceptable and perfect will of God.”

(Optional Additional Reading: Psalm 37:5)

THINK IT THROUGH:

Everyone wants to know God’s will. But Paul makes it clear: clarity comes on the other side of surrender. When we lay down our plans, our control, and our agenda, God begins to reveal His good and perfect will. It’s not about prying into the future—it’s about trusting that His way is best today. As we surrender, the fog clears and His direction becomes more visible.

PUT IT INTO PRACTICE:

Today, write down one decision or area of uncertainty you’re facing. Pray over it and intentionally surrender it to the Lord. Ask Him to guide you, not by giving all the answers at once, but by leading step by step.

PRAYER FOR TODAY:

“Lord, I trust Your will above my own. Guide my steps today as I surrender my plans into Your hands.”

GO FURTHER

Share with a trusted friend or mentor what area you’re surrendering, and ask them to pray with you for God’s direction.
