 - Why is a belief in the death and resurrection of Christ so vital to our faith?
 - Why did the rulers find it hard to suppress the Apostles message? Acts 4:13-16, 19-22
 - What did the Apostles do on being released? Acts 4:23-31
 - What was the immediate result of the prayers in Acts 4? Acts 4:31
- 4. How would describe the way you pray? What's keeping you from changing your small prayers into bold prayers?
- 5. On a scale of 1 to 10, how amazed are people by your boldness? How would living more boldly change your life?
- 6. Talk about a recent time when you had an opportunity to share your faith or were bold for Jesus. What happened?
- 7. Think about the people you interact with. What opportunities do you have to be bold in your faith this coming week?
- 8. How is God calling you to live boldly? Consider this question this week, and then commit to pursuing whatever God sets in front of you.
