Good Friday The reactions at the cross Luke 23:33-43

'The people stood watching, and the rulers even sneered at him. They said, "He saved others; let him save himself if he is the Christ of God, the Chosen One." The soldiers also came up and mocked him. They offered him wine vinegar and said, "If you are the king of the Jews, save yourself." There was a written notice above him, which read: THIS IS THE KING OF THE JEWS. One of the criminals who hung there hurled insults at him: "Aren't you the Christ? Save yourself and us!"'

1. The _____ of the crucifixion of Christ.

'When they came to the place called the Skull, there they crucified him, along with the criminals—one on his right, the other on his left.' Luke 23:33 NIV

'Jesus, remember me when you come into your kingdom.'
Luke 23:42 NIV

'There they offered Jesus wine to drink, mixed with gall; but after tasting it, he refused to drink it.' Matthew 27:34 NIV

2. The _____ of the crucifixion of Christ.

'My God, my God, why have you forsaken me?' Psalm 22:1 NIV

'Many bulls surround me; strong bulls of Bashan encircle me. Roaring lions tearing their prey open their mouths wide against me.' Psalm 22:12-13 NIV

'I am poured out like water, and all my bones are out of joint. My heart has turned to wax; it has melted away within me. My strength is dried up like a potsherd, and my tongue sticks to the roof of my mouth; you lay me in the dust of death. Dogs have surrounded me; a band of evil men has encircled me, they have pierced my hands and my feet. I can count all my bones;

people stare and gloat over me. They divide my garments among them and cast lots for my clothing.'

2. The _____ religious rulers.

'and the rulers even sneered at him. They said, "He saved others; let him save himself if he is the Christ of God, the Chosen One.'" Luke 23:35 NIV

'All who see me mock me; they hurl insults, shaking their heads: "He trusts in the Lord; let the Lord rescue him. Let him deliver him, since he delights in him.'" Psalm 22:7 NIV

3. The _____ soldiers.

'The soldiers also came up and mocked him. They offered him wine vinegar and said, "If you are the king of the Jews, save yourself.'" Luke 23:36-37 NIV

'Pilate had a notice prepared and fastened to the cross. It read: JESUS OF NAZARETH, THE KING OF THE JEWS. Many of the Jews read this sign, for the place where Jesus was crucified was near the city, and the sign was written in Aramaic, Latin and Greek. The chief priests of the Jews protested to Pilate, "Do not write 'The King of the Jews', but that this man claimed to be king of the Jews." Pilate answered, "What I have written, I have written.'" John 19:19-22 NIV

'And they divided up his clothes by casting lots.'

4. The _____ criminals.

'One of the criminals who hung there hurled insults at him: "Aren't you the Christ? Save yourself and us!"' Luke 23:39 NIV
