- 6. One of the key verses in the Bible is Genesis 2:24 in regard to marriage. How do you understand this verse today? What are some of the things a couple should hold onto and what are some things they need to let go of?
- 7. 1 John 1:9. No good marriages happen without forgiveness. It's one of the essentials of a good marriage or any other relationship for that matter. You must constantly be forgiving. Why, and what does that look like in marriage?
