Tell a trusted 'Confess your sins to each other and pray for each other so God can hea you.' James 5:16 NCV

 - How does feeling shame (feeling bad about what we've done) not work in dealing with our guilt?
 - How does trying to hide what we've done not work in dealing with our guilt?
 - How does blaming something or someone else not work in dealing with our guilt?

- 5. What does Psalm 69:5 tell us God knows?
 - Since God already knows what we've done, why does he ask us to confess?
 - Why is 'agreeing with God' about our sin an important part of confession?
- 6. How does Hebrews 10:22 tell us to approach God?
 - How does remembering that he is 'faithful and just' encourage us to trust God with our sin?
 - How does God's grace help us become the person he wants us to be?
- 7. According to John 3:18, what promise is made to those who trust Christ?
 - Why is it difficult for some people to accept the complete cleansing that God promises?
 - How does understanding God's grace help us to accept his forgiveness?
