 - Read 2 Samuel 9:1–13 and Luke 15:11–32 to see examples of grace being given as a totally free gift. Discuss the personal circumstances of the recipients at the time the gift was offered to them.
 - When we receive God's gift by faith, we become members of his family. What are some of the blessings we can enjoy as members of this family?

 - Why do some people think they are not 'good enough' for heaven?
 - Sharing the Good News of salvation is our mission. How can understanding grace help us present this message to unbelievers?
- 5. Who has brought the gift of grace to us according to John 1:17 and Romans 5:15b?
 - Why is Jesus Christ the only way to heaven?
 - The Bible often speaks of believers being in Christ. How does this describe the way God sees us?
- 6. What is God's free gift in Romans 6:23?
 - How does knowing that we have eternal life change our perspective of life here on earth?
 - What things might people do differently if they truly believe they have eternal life?
