SMALL GROUP SERMON DISCUSSION

1. In order for you to trust somebody you must have three things in that relationship: 1. That person must tell you the truth. 2. That person must be fair. 3. That person must be reliable. Why do you think these three things are important in a relationship? Read Psalm 33:4. Discuss how God has all three of those characteristics.
2. Discuss the three things God cannot do. How does knowing these three things about God help you to trust Him even when you don't understand what is going on in your life, even when things seem difficult?
3. Read 1 John 1:9. What does this verse mean to you? How does it encourage you?
4. Read Proverbs 3:5-6. In what ways can we depend on God to guide our lives? How have you personally seen this?
5. When you've been hurt do you ever find yourself wanting to get even with that person? Why does revenge never work? Discuss Romans 12:19.
6. If you live for yourself, you will never be content. What is it about people that are generous with their money and with their time that really brings life? See Proverbs 11:25, Proverbs 19:17, Proverbs 22:9.
7. Read Hebrews 6:10. How does this verse encourage you to keep going when you are serving or doing the right thing and no one else seems to notice?
8. Review the 6 promises in the message outline. Which one is most important to you at this time in your life? Why?
