

1. Focus on what we have in _____ not our differences. 'Let us <u>concentrate</u> on the things which create harmony and the growth of our fellowship together.' Romans 14:19 JBP

'Welcome people who are weak in faith, but don't get into an argument over differences of opinion.' Romans 14:1 GW

'When there is jealousy among you and you quarrel with one another, doesn't this

prove that you belong to this world, living by its standards? When one of you says, "I follow Paul," and another, "I follow Apollos"—aren't you acting like worldly people? After all, who is Apollos? And who is Paul? We are simply God's servants, by whom you were led to believe. Each one of us does the work which the Lord gave him to do.'

2. Don't be pulled into the world's

'Don't have anything to do with foolish and stupid arguments, because you know they produce guarrels. And the Lord's servant must not guarrel; instead, he must be kind to everyone, able to teach, not resentful. Those who oppose him he must gently instruct, in the hope that God will grant them repentance leading them to a knowledge of the truth.' 2 Timothy 2:23-25 NIV

4. Offer instead of criticism.

'Let's use all our energy in getting along with each other. Help each other by using encouraging words; Don't drag others down by finding fault.' Romans 14:19-20 MSG

'A wise, mature person is known for his understanding. The more pleasant his words, the more persuasive he is.' Proverbs 16:21 TEV

'What right do you have to criticize someone else's servants? Only their Lord can decide if they are doing right.' Romans 14:4 CEV

'Why do you criticize and judge your brother or sister in Christ? Why do you think you are better than they are? We'll all be judged one day, not by each other's standards, or even by our own, but by the judgment of God.' Romans 14:10 JBP

- 2. What does Ephesians 4:4-6 tell us about what all believers share? Is unity conformity? Why or why not? In order to focus on unity, what distractions do we need to put aside?
- 3. What qualities do we need in order to replace negative words and actions with positive ones? (See 2 Timothy 2:23-24.) What steps can you take to avoid being influenced by the world, knowing how difficult it is to avoid quarrels?
- 4. What was happening in the Corinthian church because of a petty issue? (See Romans 14:20 and 1 Corinthians 3:2-5.) What positive things can we focus on to foster unity and avoid divisiveness in our relationships?
- 5. What does Ephesians 4:2 encourage us to do when tempted to be critical of others? Share a time when you judged a person and then found out later what they were going through. How did that change your perspective?
- 6. What do Proverbs 16:21 and Romans 14:4 tell us about interacting with others?
- 7. According to 1 Peter 3:8, what describes unity? Which one of these character traits can you practice this week? What would it be like to turn that practice into a habit?
- 8. Unity is not an easy goal or Jesus would not need to pray for us, John 17:20-21. What action(s) can you take right now that will increase our unity?
