SMALL GROUP SERMON DISCUSSION

- 1. What are some of the values and things the world says are important?
- 2. Read Hebrews 11:23-27. Moses knew his identity and his purpose. Like Moses, we need to focus on what is and isn't important in life. Moses understood three basic truths that are in direct opposition to what the world values: 1) Fulfilling God's purpose is better than popularity 2) Loving God's people is better than pleasure 3) Having God's peace is better than possessions. Why is it important to define *who we are* based on God's values and not the values of the world?
- 3. Because Moses knew his priorities, he was able to walk away from all that most of us spend our lives pursuing. Why do you think it's important to know your top priorities?
- 4. According to Philippians 3:8, how do the things of this world compare to knowing Christ? Read this verse in one or two other translations. Which translation helps you understand this idea the most, and why?
- 5. Read Hebrews 11:27. Egypt in this passage represents the idea of slavery and bondage to a past that Satan loves to remind us of. When we recognize who we are, we receive courage to leave the past behind and courage to keep going. God uses areas of loss to develop us. So what is your Egypt?
- 6. Read 2 Corinthians 4:16-18. What do you find surprising, shocking even, about what Paul says here. What do you find encouraging too?
- 7. Read Hebrews 12:2. Endurance is a word that describes Moses. With Jesus as a role model and his Word as a guide, what do you need to "never lose sight of" in order finish the race?
