Living by Faith ~6 Trusting God or testing God? Exodus 17:1-7

'Whenever trouble comes your way, let it be an opportunity for joy. For when your <u>faith is</u> <u>tested</u>, your endurance has a chance to grow. So let it grow, for when it is fully developed you will be <u>strong in character</u> and ready for anything!' James 1:2-4 NLT

Who are we, that you should grumble against us?" Moses also said, "You will know that it was the Lord when he gives you meat to eat in the evening and all the bread you want in the morning, because he has heard your grumbling against him. Who are we? You are not grumbling against us, but against the Lord." Exodus 16:6-8 NIV

'But the people were thirsty for water there, and they grumbled against Moses. They said, "Why did you bring us up out of Egypt to make us and our children and livestock die of thirst?" Then Moses cried out to the Lord, "What am I to do with these people? They are almost ready to stone me." Exodus 17:3-4 NIV
