

### SMALL GROUP SERMON DISCUSSION

- 1. Read Romans 8:28 which teaches us that everything that happens in our lives, no matter how we perceive those things, is working together for the good of those who believe. Why is this true? How is it easier to experience life with the perspective that God is behind it all?
- 2. In Philippians 1:12, Paul demonstrates wisdom about events in his life by verbalizing God's perspective, rather than his own. Share an event in your life that turned out to be a witness to unbelievers and an encouragement to believers.
- 3. Read Philippians 1:15-18. Each of us can identify our critics, companions, competitors, and challengers. How does understanding their roles in our lives help us to avoid letting them control our attitude? What are some techniques we can use to overcome their specific tactics?
- 4. Read Philippians 1:19-20. In order to choose happiness, Paul states we should have complete faith, regardless of what the outcome may be. When we have pain, problems, pressure, or people in our lives causing us unhappiness, how does trusting God through knowing his perspective, prayers from others, the Holy Spirit's assistance, and faith in God's deliverance help us to bolster our faith and happiness?
- 5. Read Philippians 1:22-25. When Paul says to live is Christ and to die is gain, he clearly understood that fulfilment in life is not achieved through selfishness or self-gratification, but through self-sacrifice. While we might not be facing a life-or-death situation as Paul was, we still face decisions that lead to either selfishness or self-sacrifice. Why is it better to choose the way of sacrifice? How is that part of God's purpose for our lives as we follow Christ?
