True Worship ~1 How to understand worship. Psalm 150:1-6

1. When we worship, make sure the Lord is _____

'Adam lay with his wife Eve, and she became pregnant and gave birth to Cain. In the course of time Cain brought some of the fruits of the soil as an offering to the Lord. But Abel brought fat portions from some of the firstborn of his flock. The Lord looked with favour on Abel and his offering, but on Cain and his offering he did not look with favour.' Genesis 4:1, 3-4 NIV

'The Lord doesn't see things the way you see them. People judge by outward appearance, but the Lord looks at the heart.' 1 Samuel 16:7 NLT

'You have come to Jesus, the one who mediates the new covenant between God and people, and to the sprinkled blood, which speaks of forgiveness instead of crying out for vengeance like the blood of Abel.' Hebrews 12:24 NLT

'By faith Abel offered God a better sacrifice than Cain did. By faith he was commended as a righteous man, when God spoke well of his offerings. And by faith he still speaks, even though he is dead.'

Hebrews 11:4 NIV

'For from him and through him and to him are all things. To him be the glory forever! Amen.' Romans 11:36 NIV
