# 1. Develop a \_\_\_\_\_ for heaven.

'This, then, is how you should pray: 'Our Father in heaven, hallowed be your name.' Matthew 6:9 NIV

'For Christ did not go into a Holy Place made by human hands, which was a copy of the real one. He went into heaven itself, where he now appears on our behalf in the presence of God.' Hebrews 9:24 TEV

'To the church of the firstborn, whose names are written in heaven.' Hebrews 12:23 NIV

'Do not rejoice that the spirits submit to you, but rejoice that your names are written in heaven.' Luke 10:20

'But we are citizens of heaven, where the Lord Jesus Christ lives. And we are eagerly waiting for him to return as our Saviour.' Philippians 3:20 NIV

'Praise be to the God and Father of our Lord Jesus Christ! In his great mercy he has given us new birth into a living hope through the resurrection of Jesus Christ from the dead, and into an inheritance that can never perish, spoil or fade—kept in heaven for you.' 1 Peter 1:3-4 NIV

# 2. Learn to \_\_\_\_\_ in light of heaven.

'We are pressed on every side by troubles, but we are not crushed. We are perplexed, but not driven to despair. We are hunted down, but never abandoned by God. We get knocked down, but we are not destroyed. Through suffering, our bodies continue to share in the death of Jesus so that the life of Jesus may also be seen in our bodies.' 2 Corinthians 4:8-10 NLT

'That is why we never give up. Though our bodies are dying, our spirits are being renewed every day. For our present troubles are small and won't last very long. Yet they produce for us a glory that vastly outweighs them and will last forever! So we don't look at the troubles we can see now; rather, we fix our gaze on things that cannot be seen. For the things we see now will soon be gone, but the things we cannot see will last forever.' 2 Corinthians 4:16-18 NLT

'For we know that when this earthly tent we live in is taken down (that is, when we die and leave this earthly body), we will have a house in heaven, an eternal body made for us by God himself and not by human hands. We grow weary in our present bodies, and we long to put on our heavenly bodies like new clothing. For we will put on heavenly bodies; we will not be spirits without bodies. While we live in these earthly bodies, we groan and sigh, but it's not that we want to die and get rid of these bodies that clothe us. Rather, we want to put on our new bodies so that these dying bodies will be swallowed up by life. God himself has prepared us for this, and as a guarantee he has given us his Holy Spirit. So we are always confident, even though we know that as long as we live in these bodies we are not at home with the Lord. For we live by believing and not by seeing. Yes, we are fully confident, and we would rather be away from these earthly bodies, for then we will be at home with the Lord.' 2 Corinthians 5:1-8 NLT

# 3. Learn to be \_\_\_\_\_about heaven. 'I was caught up to the third heaven.' 2 Corinthians 12:2 NLT 1. The \_\_\_\_heaven. 'As the heavens are higher than the earth, so are my ways higher than your ways and my thoughts than your thoughts. As the rain and the snow come down from heaven.' Isaiah 55:9-10 NIV 'He covers the heavens with clouds, provides rain for the earth, and makes the grass grow in mountain pastures.' Psalm 147:8 NLT

### 2. The heaven.

'And God said, "Let there be lights in the expanse of the heavens to separate the day from the night. And let them be for signs and for seasons, and for days and years, and let them be lights in the expanse of the heavens to give light upon the earth."' Genesis 1:14-15 ESV

### 3. The heaven

'The heavens, even the highest heaven, cannot contain you. How much less this temple I have built!' 1 Kings 8:27 NIV

'For this is what the high and lofty One says— he who lives forever, whose name is holy: "I live in a high and holy place." Isaiah 57:15 NIV

'Look down from heaven and see from your lofty throne, holy and glorious.' Isaiah 63:15 NIV
