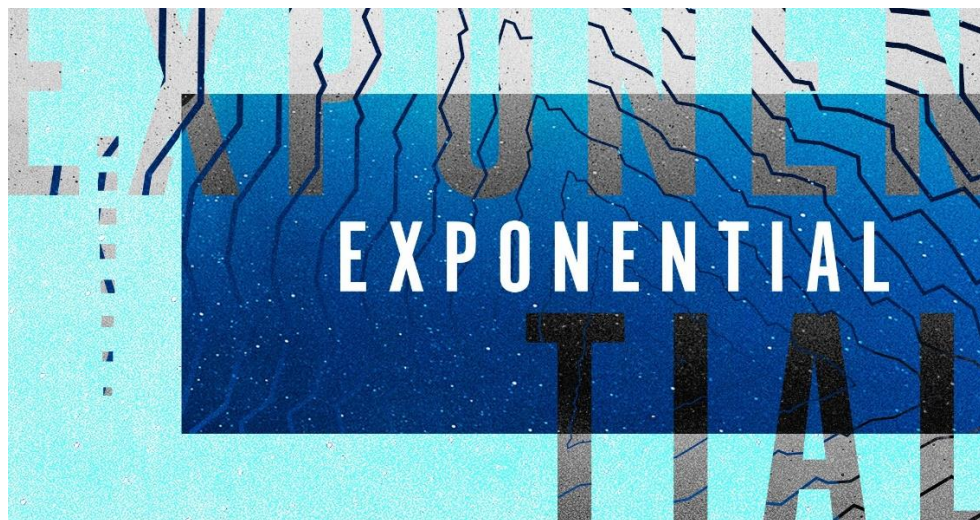

'You are the salt of the earth. You are the light of the world. A city on a hill cannot be hidden. Neither do people light a lamp and put it under a bowl. Instead, they put it on its stand, and it gives light to everyone in the house. In the same way, let your light shine before men, that they may see your good deeds and praise your Father in heaven.'

Matthew 5:13-16 NIV

'The woman was surprised, for Jews refuse to have anything to do with Samaritans. She said to Jesus, "You are a Jew, and I am a Samaritan woman. Why are you asking me for a drink?" Jesus replied, "If you only knew the gift God has for you and who you are speaking to, you would ask me, and I would give you living water."' John 4:9-10 NLT

"But sir, you don't have a rope or a bucket," she said, "and this is a very deep well. Where would you get this living water?" Jesus replied, "Anyone who drinks this water will soon become thirsty again. But those who drink the water I give will never be thirsty again." John 4:11-14 NLT

"Please, sir," the woman said, "give me some of that water!" "Go and get your husband," Jesus told her. "I don't have a husband," the woman replied. Jesus said, "You're right! You don't have a husband—for you have had five husbands, and you aren't even married to the man you're living with now." "Sir" the woman said, "you must be a prophet." John 4:15-19 NLT

'The woman left her water jar beside the well and ran back to the village, telling everyone, "Come and see a man who told me everything I ever did! Could he possibly be the Messiah?" So the people came streaming from the village to see him.' John 4:28-30 NLT

Every part of the body _____.

'Yes, the body has many different parts, not just one part. If the foot says, "I am not a part of the body because I'm not the hand," that does not make it any less a part of the body. And if the ear says, "I am not a part of the body because I am only an ear and not an eye," would that make it any less a part of the body? Suppose the whole body were an eye—then how would you hear? Or if your whole body were just one big ear, how could you smell anything?' 1 Corinthians 12:14-17 NLT
