True Worship ~6 How to worship when life doesn't make sense. Genesis 22:1-19

'Therefore I urge you in view of God's mercy to offer your bodies as living sacrifices wholly and pleasing to God. This is your spiritual act of worship.' Romans 12:1 NIV

'Some time later God tested Abraham. He said to him, "Abraham!" "Here I am," he replied. Then God said, "Take your son, your only son, Isaac, whom you love, and go to the region of Moriah. Sacrifice him there as a burnt offering on one of the mountains I will tell you about." Early the next morning Abraham got up and saddled his donkey. He said to his servants, "Stay here with the donkey while I and the boy go over there. We will worship and then we will come back to you." Genesis 22:1-5 NIV

1. Stop and _____ to God.

'Later on God tested Abraham's faith and obedience. "Abraham!" God called. "Yes," he replied. "Here I am." Genesis 22:1 NLT

2. Neglect what's natural and be _____ to God

'Then God said, "Take your son, your only son, Isaac, whom you love, and go to the region of Moriah. Sacrifice him there as a burnt offering on one of the mountains I will tell you about." Early the next morning Abraham got up and saddled his donkey. He took with him two of his servants and his son Isaac. When he had cut enough wood for the burnt offering, he set out for the place God had told him about. On the third day Abraham looked up and saw the place in the distance.' Genesis 22:1-4 NIV
