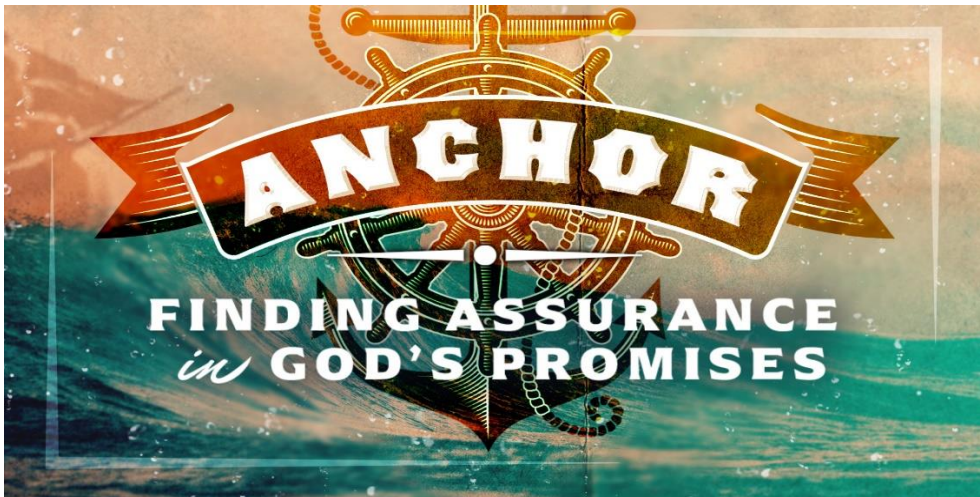

## Anchor ~6

### How to have stability because God is unchangeable Isaiah 46:3-13

'Every good and perfect gift is from above, coming down from the Father of the heavenly lights, who does not change like shifting shadows.' James 1:17 NIV

'With [God] there is never the slightest variation or shadow of inconsistency.'  
James 1:17 JBP

'I the Lord do not change!' Malachi 3:6 NIV

'For I am God, and there is no other; I am God, and there is none like me, declaring the end from the beginning and from ancient times things not yet done, saying, 'My counsel shall stand, and I will accomplish all my purpose.' I have spoken, and I will bring it to pass; I have purposed, and I will do it.' Isaiah 46:9-11 ESV

'God is not a man, that he should lie. He is not a human, that he should change his mind. Has he ever spoken and failed to act? Has he ever promised and not carried it through?' Numbers 23:19 NLT

'In the beginning you laid the foundations of the earth, and the heavens are the work of your hands. They will perish, but you remain; they will all wear out like a garment. Like clothing you will change them and they will be discarded. But you remain the same, and your years will never end.' Psalm 102:25-27 NIV

#### 1. God's \_\_\_\_\_ never changes.

God: 'I have loved you with an everlasting love.' Jeremiah 31:3 NIV

'God's love is eternal and his faithfulness lasts forever.' Psalm 100:5 TEV

'Your love never changes, so save me!' Psalm 119:15 TEV

#### I never need to \_\_\_\_\_ God's love.

'Nothing will be able to separate us from the love of God.' Romans 8:38 NIV

'I lift my eyes to the hills – where does my help come from? My help comes from the Lord, the maker of heaven and earth.' Psalm 121:1-2 NIV

'But I have hope when I think of this: the Lord's love never ends; His mercies never stop. They are new every morning.' Lamentations 3:21-23 NCV

## 2. God's \_\_\_\_\_ never changes.

'The grass withers and flowers fade, but the Word of our God shall stand forever.' Isaiah 40:8 LB

'Heaven and earth will pass away, but My words will never pass away.' Matthew 24:35 NIV

'Long ago I learned from your statues that you established them to last forever.' Psalm 119:152 NIV

'Did God really say you couldn't eat of that?' Genesis 3:1 NIV

## 3. God's \_\_\_\_\_ never changes.

'The Lord Almighty has sworn, 'Surely as I have planned it, so it will be, and as I have purposed, so it will stand.' Isaiah 14:24 NIV

'(God) is not a man -- He does not change His mind.' 1 Samuel 15:29 GN

'When God saw what they did and how they turned from their evil ways, he had compassion and did not bring upon them the destruction he had threatened.' Jonah 3:10 NIV

'His ways are eternal.' Habakkuk 3:6 NIV

## God does not have a \_\_\_\_\_ for my life.

'All things work together for the good of those who love God—those whom he has called according to his plan.' Romans 8:28 GN

'I have come that they may have life, and have it to the full.' John 10:10 NIV

1. Are you someone who likes or dislikes change? When can change be good and when can change bring stress?
2. Read James 1:17. James reminds us that since good gifts have always come from God, we can be confident that only good gifts will come from him in the future, because God's character never changes in the slightest. How does that help you view God?
3. Read Isaiah 46:9-11. God is unchanging in his promises. How does that help you when you read the Bible and when you pray?
4. Read Jeremiah 31:3 and Psalm 100:5. How is God's love different from human love?
5. Read Romans 8:38. Why do I never need to doubt God's love for me?
  - How does God's love help me each day? See Psalm 121:1-2 and Lamentations 3:21-23.
6. Read Isaiah 40:8. Why can we trust the Word of God?
  - How can we do what Jesus tells us to do in Matthew 5:24?
7. Read Isaiah 14:24. How does this verse remind us that God has a plan for each of our lives?
  - Why is there no such thing as a Plan B for each of our lives?
