- 6. Read 1 Corinthians 12:21-22, 27. Why should every person in a church serve? What are some of the roadblocks people have in not volunteering to serve and how might we encourage them to get involved in serving at church?
- 7. Read Hebrews 10:24-25 and Job 6:14. Describe all the ways Life Groups are key to authentic fellowship.
- 8. Read 1 Corinthians 9:19-23. Discuss ways in which we can reach people for Jesus and how we should be creative in reaching people in our lives who don't know Jesus yet.
